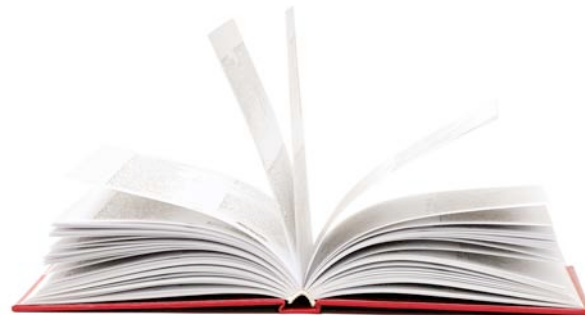




Advisory Council Newsletter March 10

■ Cost per person will be €2.5 and it needs to be teams of 4 to 6 people.

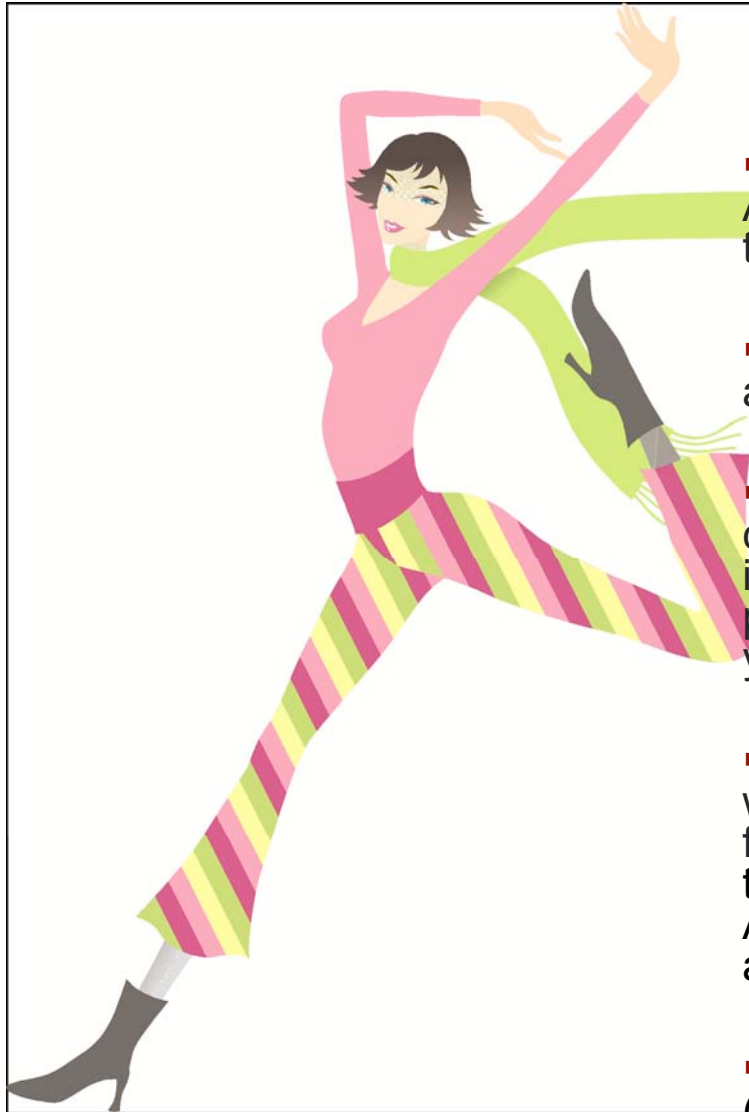
■ The winning team will get a prize and after the contest we will have a raffle for a great video camera. You will be able to buy tickets for the raffle the same day at €2 each.
